Original PJHS 2nd Story Building Renovation Complete for School Opening



Fifth graders at Patterson Jr. High School will finally get their just reward when school begins on August 8, 2018, as they walk into a fully renovated facility. The newly constructed junior high school was completed for 6 through 8 graders for the 2017 –2018 school year, while promising 5th graders that the 2nd story building would be like new; and, "A picture is worth a thousand words," as they say.

Principal Mark Spradling said that last school year was a great year at PJHS; and now that construction is complete, this will be an even greater school year. He went on to say, "We have such a beautiful school that houses the best students in the Parish. I would like to personally thank everyone who supported this endeavor. The outside brick of the original (old) building is identical to that of the new school. But the inside has been transformed to stand up to any other state of the art instructional facility.
